Statement – response by Shaykh Haytham Tamim

'I would like to respond to the escalation of comments and reaction made in response to the new Muslim marriage contract, which was launched in August 2008 by the Muslim institute. The overall premise, on which the contract was based upon, in order to assist many Muslim women who had great difficulty exiting a troublesome marriage, was something I worked upon with others in cooperation. However I did not at any point endorse specific points like; dismissing the need and presence of two Muslim male witnesses, as required by Shari'ah law. The presentation of the contract as I understand it, now appeared to have been taken out of context and I hereby confirm that I would not and I did not endorse anything which would fall outside the bounds of the Shari'ah and those matters which are clear. I was not aware of any point such as the point mentioned above and if this was brought to my attention I would not endorse such a contract.'
